The Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study (CAGS) in Reading program is designed for educators holding a Master's degree who are interested in expanding their knowledge in specialized areas of reading and literacy. A 30-credit-hour curriculum balances content and pedagogical knowledge, focusing on strengthening language and critical thinking skills while expanding programmatic uses of resources and technologies. You will progress through the program with a cohort of fellow professionals, affording countless opportunities to share and learn from each other's experiences.

The CAGS in Reading program complements the credentials of classroom teachers, special educators, speech and language pathologists, administrators, psychologists and private tutors. Graduates are prepared for roles as reading and literacy supervisors, curriculum specialists, resource personnel, program administrators and program consultants.

This program is designed to graduate licensed reading professionals.

Hybrid classes will be held in the evenings or courses will be totally online.
